 - c. How your skills and experience suit the role
 - d. Three examples of your work as outlined below:

 - ii. An example social media post for Compassion's Facebook page that outlines the importance of our Education and Training Critical Need and encourages readers to give. Christ-centred

Statement of Faith

- Develop, maintain and promote relevant policies, processes and guidelines in order to promote and protect Compassion's brand (e.g. IP, branding, messaging, public relations, advertising)
- Undertake regular professional development in order to maintain and improve skills, respond
