#### **Primary Purpose**

In response to God's calling and in the power of the Holy Spirit, the Film (Video) Specialist is responsible for providing high quality video and audio services in the creation of marketing resources for Compassion Australia.

#### **Key Accountabilities**

- Provide end-to-end audio-visual media production services including internal consulting, scriptwriting, storyboarding, camera operation, sound recording, editing, colouring and publishing.
- Liaise with external production companies, design studios and other third-party suppliers as needed in order to provide briefings, video direction etc ensuring that work is delivered on budget and within agreed timeframes.
- Undertake regular professional development in order to maintain a high level of proficiency for all software and equipment used in film production.
- Liaise with other Compassion partner countries and the Global Ministry Centre to exchange relevant marketing material as required.
- · Travel interstate and internationally (to developing countries) in a production role as required.
- Maintain and promote relevant policies, processes and guidelines in order to promote and protect Compassion's interests (eg. IP, branding, Public Relations, advertising)
- Other relevant duties as required

- Exemplary visual storytelling skills with deep knowledge of the narrative journey.
- Exemplary creative thinking and problem-solving skills across the film production process.
- Exemplary technical ability in video editing software (PP or FCP).

- Exemplary technical ability with Apple Macs.
- · Ability to work individually and in a team, including directing internal/external teams and
- production crews.
- Knowledge of the film/video production process.
- Ability to work independently to deadlines.
- Effective presentation, communication and organisational skills.
- Ability to learn new technologies and equipment easily.
- Qualifications in film, communication, marketing, or equivalent.
